RESERVATIONS

Reservations for boarding must be made in advance. If we are already full for the dates you need we will be happy to call you if a cancellation arises.

For pets that will be boarding for more than one week, a deposit of 1/2 of the estimated charges may be required at check in. Boarding charges must be paid in full upon discharge.

We recommend that you leave a telephone number where we can reach you in case of an emergency. If you are unable to be reached, please leave the phone number of a person who can act as your representative in your absence.

KENNELS

Dogs are kenneled indoors and are taken to outside runs twice a day. While inside, pets are kept in air-conditioned wards. The outside runs are sheltered, with a roof and walls on three sides.

Cats are kept in a ward separated from the dogs.

Any animals that are found to have live fleas will be treated with Advantage, and the charge will be added to the boarding bill.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

Proof of current vaccinations is required of all boarders for which we have no records.

Required Dog Vaccinations

Distemper/Parvo (DA2PP)

Kennel Cough (Bordetella)

Rabies

Leptospirosis

(some distemper vaccinations contain the Lepto vaccination; ask your veterinarian to be sure.)

Required Cat Vaccinations

Distemper (FVRCP)

Rabies

If vaccinations are not up to date upon arrival, we will update your pet's vaccinations, and you will be charged accordingly.

FEEDING

You are welcome to bring your pet's food from home if you'd like. Otherwise, we feed Hill's Science Diet formulas to our boarders. If your pet has digestive upset (vomiting or diarrhea), a stool sample will be analyzed for worms. If positive for parasites, an appropriate dewormer will be given. If negative, we will give your pet medication to control simple digestive upset. Charges will be made for any tests and medicines administered.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP

You may drop your pet off any time during our regular business hours. Please make sure that your pet is either on a leash or in a cage or carrier when coming into the hospital.

Charges begin on the day of drop off and are charged each day at noon. If you would like your pet to have their favorite toy during their stay, you may bring it. Please bring only one toy. We provide towels and blankets for your pet's comfort; there is no need to bring one from home.

MEDICATIONS

If your pet is on special medication (thyroid, antibiotics, joint supplements, etc.), we are happy to give it to them while they are here. There is an additional charge of \$2-4/day for this service. We reserve the right to change any medication in the event of an emergency.

Please inquire about special rates for your diabetic pet.

When you get your pet home,
please don't immediately feed or give a lot of water.
Wait until your pet has quieted down. This will minimize stomach upset.
